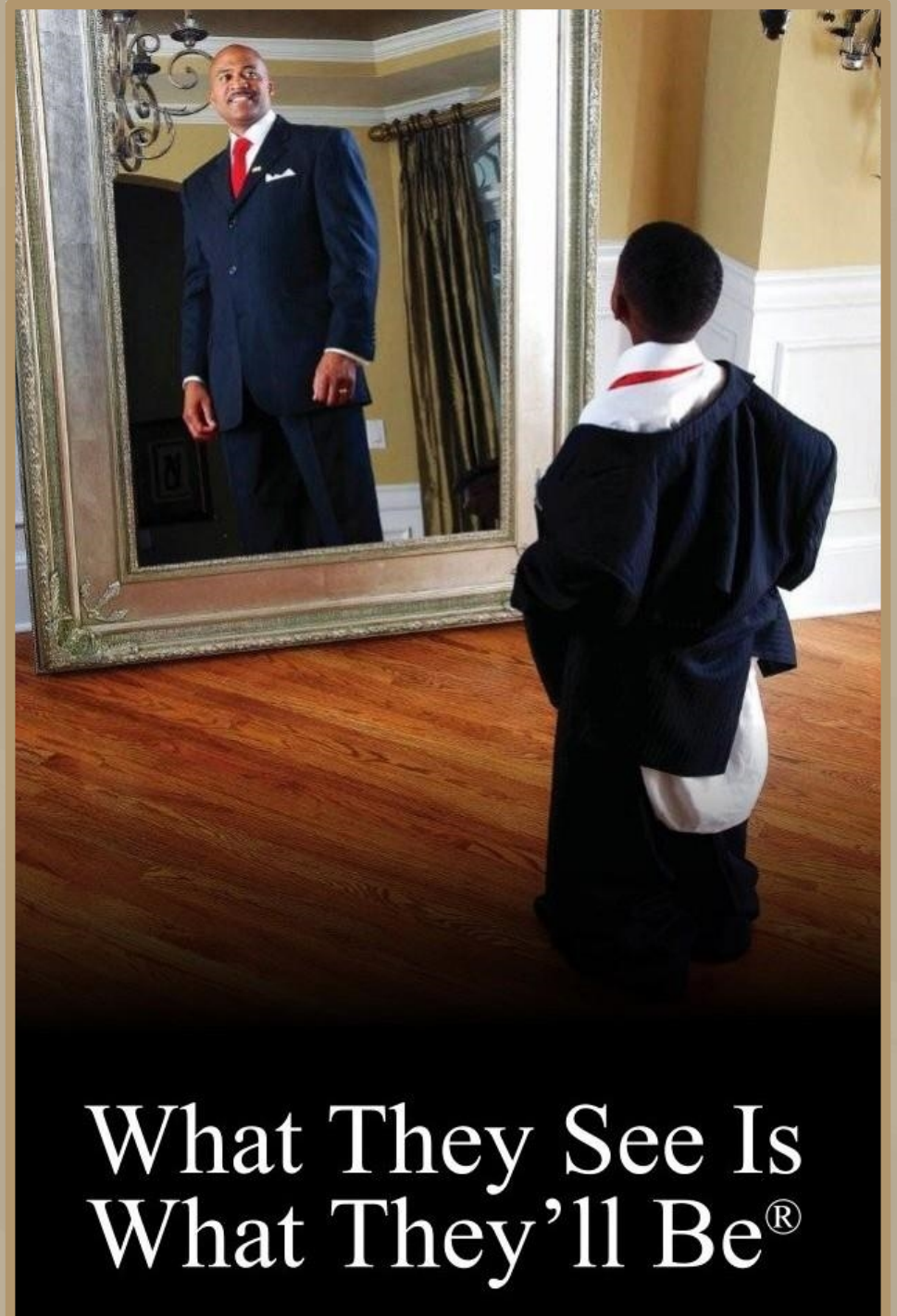

- Unique business-like approach to our non-profit mission

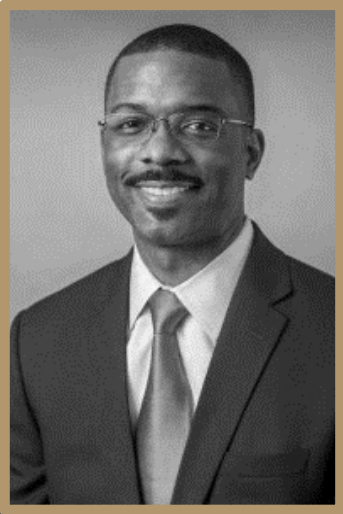


HISTORY OF NORTH METRO ATLANTA CHAPTER

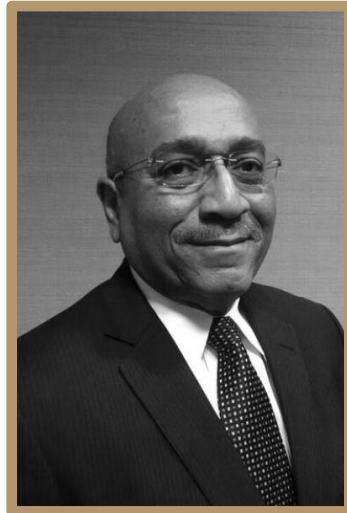

MENTORING

The North Metro Chapter is especially proud of the high school graduation rate of 100% and a college entrance rate of 98% with the remaining 2% entering military service or enrolling in a technical/trade program. Our members are dedicated professional men who donate their time, talent, and energy to improving the lives of the mentees enrolled in the MOT program.

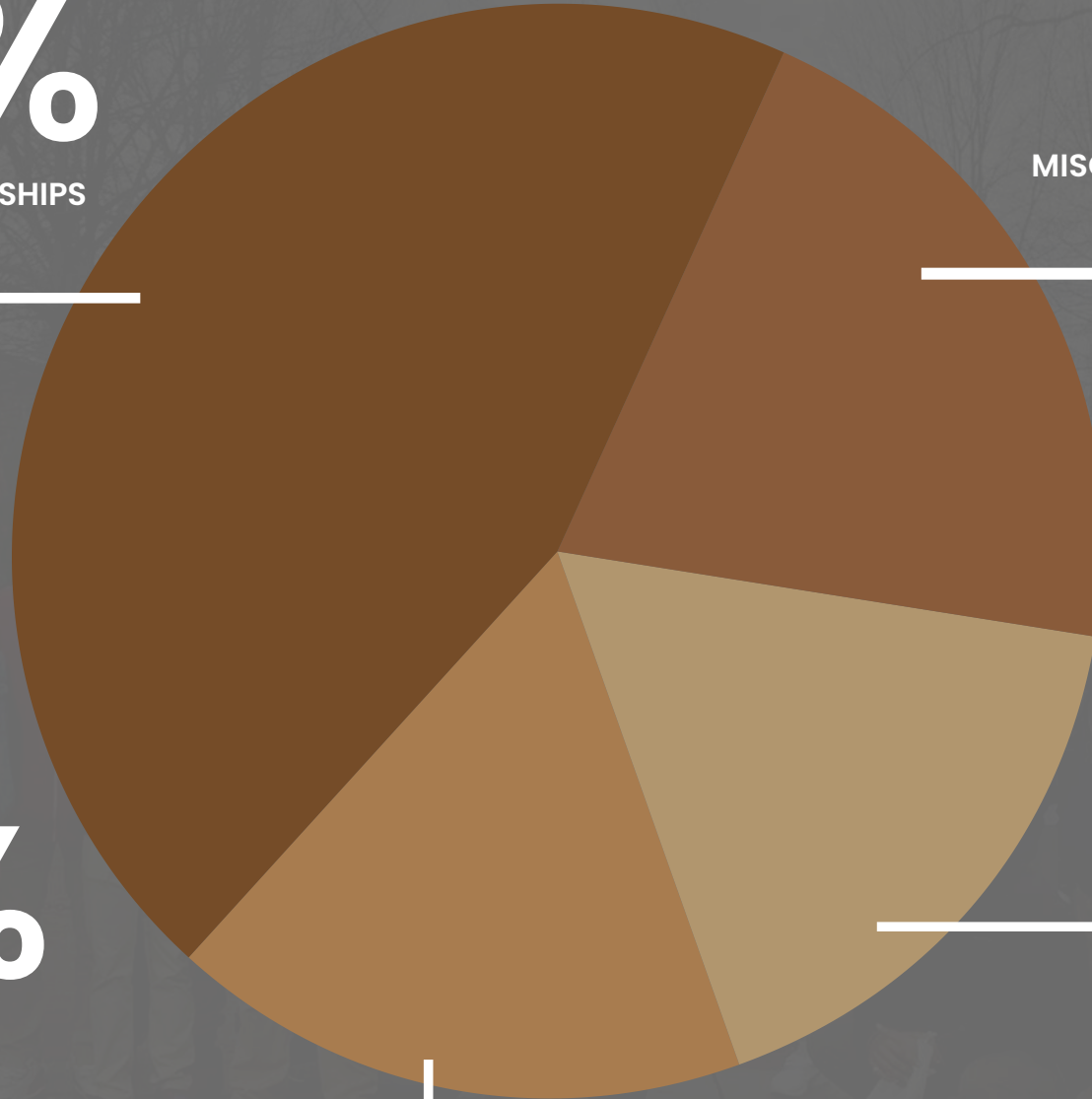
